

Tri-County Homeless Street-Need Resources

Charleston, Berkeley, and Dorchester Counties - focused on helping people where they are: meals, showers, laundry, hygiene, clothing, phones/mail, warming centers, basic-needs navigation, and walk-in resource points.

This is not a shelter-bed vacancy list and not a long-term housing placement list. Use it for immediate support while someone is still outside, in a vehicle, in a motel, doubled-up, or otherwise unstable. Hours and eligibility change frequently, especially for weather shelters, so call or check Facebook before sending someone.

Quick call script

“Hi, I am helping someone who is currently unhoused / sleeping outside / sleeping in a vehicle / staying in a motel. I am not asking for long-term housing right now. I need immediate help where they are: meals, showers, laundry, clothing, hygiene, phone/mail access, warming center information, or basic-needs referrals. What can they access today, what time should they come, and what documents do they need?”

What to ask every resource

1	Are walk-ins accepted today, or do they need an appointment/referral?
2	Do they need ID, proof of county residence, income proof, Social Security card, or benefits letter?
3	Can they receive help if they are in a car, tent, hotel, woods, or couch-surfing?
4	Do you offer showers, laundry, clothing, hygiene items, phone charging, mail, meals, transportation, or medical referrals?
5	Is there a different number/Facebook page for same-day schedule changes?

Source notes

Details were checked against official organization, county, city, United Way, CoC, or directory pages where available. Facebook pages are included because local outreach groups often post schedule changes there before websites are updated.
